- Discussion of alternative aims for WG1: What are we missing?

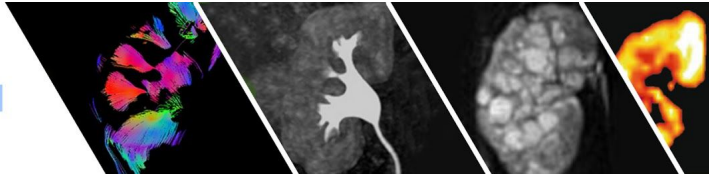
WG2:

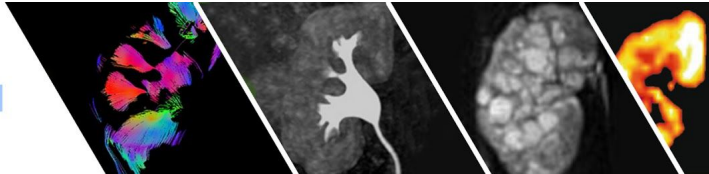
3. **STSM - Grants still available - join forces!**
